**Subject:** **Code Grey Air Quality Precautions**

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To all residents and families,

Please be advised that we are monitoring the air quality in response to the current smoke conditions caused by the wildfires. The **Air Quality Health Index (AQHI)** is currently rated **Very High Risk** and sites have initiated the "Code Grey" emergency response protocols for air exclusion (meaning the poor air quality outside is determined to be a danger to people inside the building).

### **Please note the following precautions are currently in place:**

- Ventilation systems have been shut down and external doors/windows are closed to stop the intake of external air into the building
- Outdoor recreation activities are cancelled, and residents are discouraged from spending time outdoors
- There is no restriction on visitation within our buildings, but visitors are asked to please avoid spending time outdoors with residents (onsite and if taking residents on outings)
- Residents are being closely monitored for air pollution and respiratory symptoms

Please be assured we will continue to monitor the Air Quality Health Index and respond as necessary with the appropriate precautions as the situation evolves. As always, the comfort and safety of our residents, staff, and everyone entering our buildings is our top priority.
